

ABSTRACT PRESENTATION RULES

Oral Presentation

The presentation must be in **English**, no exception.

The presentation of the abstract must follow the design of the given PowerPoint template, which can be found on the congress website.

The presentation must be 10 slides long and 50MB at most. Any presentation that exceeds 10 slides and 50MB size will be automatically excluded.

The slide size must be 16:9 (widescreen).

The font and color must be the ones given on the template.

All authors and the main institution they belong to must be shown below the title, on the first slide.

Time of presentation will be 10 minutes, followed by 3 minutes for discussion. The use of audiovisual aid is permitted.

If the presentation contains images, these must be high quality, but please remember that the overall size of the file must not exceed 50MB.

If the presentation was created in an Apple device, it must be transferred to Windows format before you send it.

If it contains video, they must be in WindowsMedia format (.avi, .wmv) or .MPEG (.mpg, .mpeg, .mpe, .mpa, .m1v, .mp2, .mpv2, .mp2v). Formats like DIVX, DVD, Real Player, VCD and QuickTime are not compatible with Microsoft PowerPoint and will only work outside of it.

No institutional logos can be added to the powerpoint template. The only logo that must be in the presentation is the congress logo.

IMPORTANT

It is not permitted to make significant changes to the presentation content regarding the abstract submitted for review. In case the committee detects any, the abstract will be automatically excluded from the congress.

Important: In order to be able to present the abstract, the presenting author must be registered for the congress.

Please, send your presentation via email to arrhythmias2019@mci-group.com before Monday 21 October 23.59hs. Every presentation sent after this date will be excluded from the congress.

The name of the file must be formed by the word ORAL and your abstract ID number, which can be found in the confirmation letter you received when submitted the abstract. For instance, if your abstract ID number is 0000, the file must be named "ORAL0000".

You will also need to take the presentation in a drive to the congress to avoid any technical issues.
